

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitor, their property, their servants, onlookers, horses or vehicles in connection with or arising from this event. It shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against legal action arising from any mishap.
2. The judge's decision is final
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry and to amend or cancel any class or the event at their discretion
4. No entry fee will be refunded except on production of a valid vet's certificate
5. Any complaints must be written out and handed to the organiser of the event within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a fee of £15 which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
6. Horses must be 4 years of age or over
7. Correctly fitted hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 with 3 point fastening secured must be worn at all times when mounted or you will be eliminated
8. Back protectors are recommended for Jumping but not compulsory
9. Any combination judged to be entered in a class for which they are not eligible may be moved to another class at the Judges' discretion.
10. Please note that all and any children remain the responsibility of their parents and/or guardians at all times and no responsibility is accepted by the organizers.
11. Any change of horse or rider must be notified to the Secretary at least 15 minutes before the start of the class
12. There must be no mucking out of trailers or lorries onto the ground. All muck and loose hay / bedding must be gathered up and taken home
13. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions all officials, stewards and organisers. Any accident, however small must be reported and recorded at the Secretary's office.
14. Horses/ponies may only enter once per class in any one competition
15. Rules in accordance with British Showjumping for club shows: Please note third refusal incurs elimination

Knock down – 4 faults First refusal – 4 faults Second refusal (anywhere on the course) – 4 faults Third refusal (anywhere on the course) – Elimination Fall (anywhere on the course) – Elimination All other faults as per British Show Jumping rule book.

League Points awarded: 1st – 12 points, 2nd - 10 points, 3rd – 8 points, 4th – 6 points, 5th – 4 points, 6th – 3 points. 3 points will be allocated to all those who achieve double clears, those who are placed will receive an additional 3 points if they have had a double clear.

CLUB LEAGUE INFORMATION

Eligibility - For any horse/ rider, pony/rider combination without a registered result in National Amateur 90cm, British Novice, Pony British Novice, Stepping Stones and above in the last 3 years.

Unaffiliated competitors can compete without being a Club Member.

Competitors can register as Club Members up to 7 days after the competition and regain points won.

Any age rider on ponies (adults eligible to ride ponies).

Children can ride horses from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached (FEI Rules).

Ponies classed as not exceeding 148cms

Horses classed as exceeding 148cms

At Club Competitions the first round or first phase of the competitions, time faults will not be allocated instead there will be a time limit of 2 minutes, competitors who exceed this will incur elimination.

All double clears will qualify for the Central Horse News and Cricklands Finals 2013
