- 2 The judge's decision is final
- 3 The organisers reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry and to amend or cancel any class or the event at their discretion
- 4 No entry fee will be refunded except on production of a valid vet's certificate
- 5 Any complaints must be written out and handed to the organiser of the event within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a fee of £15 which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
- 6 Horses must be 4 years of age or over
- 7 Correctly fitted hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 with 3 point fastening secured must be worn at all times when mounted or you will be eliminated.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Any combination judged to be entered in a class for which they are not eligible may be moved to another class at the Judges' discretion.

All tests may be ridden in any official CRC long sleeved shirt instead of a jacket
