Grid reference SU785865. Hambleden's access is opposite Henley Management College on the A4155 between Henley and Marlow. If using internet to find directions please use postcode (RG9 3AS).

If coming on the M40, Exit at Junction 4 (High Wycombe) and follow signs to Marlow and then follow the A4155 to Henley. If coming on the M4, Exit at Junction 8/9 (Maidenhead), and follow the Bypass to Marlow. The A4155 to Henley is signposted from Marlow. (\*\*DO NOT TAKE THE TURNING TO HAMBLEDEN. DO NOT TURN INTO DAIRY LANE\*\*).

All entries should be made through Riding club team managers and are only open to clubs in Area 6. For further details of eligibility please see BRC 2010 rules. Prelim entries need to be made to Head Office for all Area competitions except Rural Riders teams.

Class 1 - Area Novice Teams – teams of 4 senior riders all riding Prelim 12 (2005)

Class 2 – L&SE Dressage – teams of 4 riders (can include 1 junior) all riding Prelim 12 (2005)

Class 3 – L&SE Riders Test – teams of 4 riders (can include 1 junior) all riding RT 11 (2010)

Class 4 – Area Riders Test – senior and junior teams and individuals. Juniors to ride RT 11 (2010) Senior teams are 2 riding RT 11(2010) and 2 riding RT 13 (2010)

Class 5 – Area Open – senior teams and individuals. Teams to have one riding each of Novice 24 (2010) Novice 28 (2008) Novice 30 (2006) Elem 45 (2010)

Class 6 – Area Junior – Junior teams and individuals. Teams to have 2 riding Prelim 12(2005) and 2 riding Novice 24 (2010)

Class 7 – Pairs – Seniors or junior pairs riding BRC Pairs 4 (2004)

Class 8 – Medium 61 – senior individuals

Class 9 – Rural Riders – test to be ridden by team of 6 together

**Please note that all and any children remain the responsibility of their parents and/or guardians at all times and no responsibility is accepted by the organisers**

- 1 No claims can be entertained for anything that may happen to competitor, their property, their servants, onlookers, horses or vehicles in connection with or arising from this event. It shall be a condition of entry that each competitor shall agree to indemnify the organisers against legal action arising from any mishap.
- 2 The chief steward's decision is final
- 3 The organisers reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry and to amend or cancel any class or the event at their discretion
- 4 No entry fee will be refunded in accordance with BRC rules
- 5 Any complaints must be written out and handed to the organiser of the event within 15 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a fee of £25 which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
- 6 Horses must be 4 years of age or over
- 7 Correctly fitted hard hats to PAS 015 or BSEN1384 with 3 point fastening secured must be worn at all times when mounted or you will be eliminated.
- 8 Riders are requested to ride sensibly at all times and within the warm up areas provided. Lunging is permissible but please ensure that this is done in a safe and sensible area. Riders and their helpers are requested to be courteous to officials who are all volunteers. Failure to do so could result in elimination.
- 9 Dogs must be on leads at all times
- 10 Please ensure that all litter is taken home and that horseboxes are not mucked out onto the showground
